<b>SPECULATION</b>	<b>NOUN</b>	Investment in stocks, property, etc. In the hope of gain but with the risk of loss.	
<b>PRUNE</b>	<b>VERB</b>	Reduce the extent of (something) by removing superfluous or unwanted parts.	Reduce, Cut, Cut Back, Cut Down
<b>INEVITABLE</b>	<b>ADJECTIVE</b>	Certain to happen; unavoidable.	Unavoidable, Inescapable, Bound To Happen, Sure To Happen
<b>RETREAT</b>	<b>VERB</b>	Move back or withdraw.	Go Out, Ebb, Recede, Flow Out, Fall, Go Down
<b>UNAMBIGUOUS</b>	<b>ADJECTIVE</b>	Not open to more than one interpretation.	Incontrovertible, Incontestable, Undeniable, Irrefutable, Unassailable,
<b>ONUS</b>	<b>NOUN</b>	Something that is one's duty or responsibility.	Burden, Responsibility, Liability, Obligation, Duty, Weight

<b>IMPERSONATION</b>	<b>NOUN</b>	An act of pretending to be another person for the purpose of entertainment or fraud.	
<b>EMBITTER</b>	<b>VERB</b>	Make (someone) feel bitter or resentful.	Make Bitter, Make Resentful, Sour, Anger, Poison
<b>SALVE</b>	<b>NOUN</b>	Something that is soothing or consoling for wounded feelings or an uneasy conscience.	
<b>MURKY</b>	<b>ADJECTIVE</b>	Obscure or morally questionable.	Questionable, Suspicious, Suspect, Dubious, Dark, Mysterious, Secret
<b>SUBTERFUGE</b>	<b>NOUN</b>	Deceit used in order to achieve one's goal.	Trickery, Intrigue, Deviousness, Evasion, Deceit, Deception
<b>UNRAVEL</b>	<b>VERB</b>	Undo (twisted, knitted, or woven threads).	Untangle, Disentangle, Straighten Out, Separate Out
<b>TUMBLE</b>	<b>VERB</b>	Fall suddenly, clumsily, or headlong.	Fall, Fall Over, Fall Down, Topple Over,
<b>LACUNA</b>	<b>NOUN</b>	An unfilled space; a gap.	Gap, Space, Absence, Lack, Deficiency, Blank, Lacuna
<b>INDISPUTABLE</b>	<b>ADJECTIVE</b>	Unable to be challenged or denied.	Incontrovertible, Incontestable, Undeniable, Irrefutable
